# Congratulations to Fr Jason who celebrates the sixth anniversary of his ordination to the priesthood this Sunday Reflection for this Sunday ....

A biblical prophet is someone who has received a divine call to speak God's word to his people. Even though the Word of God could be a hard word, it was a word of love because it meant that God had not abandoned his people. God's spokesman had to be prepared for opposition and rejection. It was so for the Old Testament prophets, and for Jesus himself. At the close of his Galilean ministry Jesus is rejected by the people of his home town, who can't bring themselves to believe in the greatness of someone who is one of themselves. Consequently, his power is ineffective there. Their rejection of him is an anticipation of his rejection by the Jewish nation as a whole.

#### SAINTS FOR THE WEEK ....

#### Tuesday Ss Augustine Zhao Rong, Priest and Companions, Martyrs

This feast commemorates 120 Chinese martyrs, who suffered between 1648 and 1930. They include European missionaries such as St Gregory Grassi (1823-1900), the Italian born Bishop of North Shanxi martyred during the Boxer rebellion, and indigenous Christians, such as St Augustine Zhao Rong, a diocesan priest put to death in 1815. They were canonised by St John Paul II in 2000.

#### Thursday Feast of St Benedict, Abbot, Patron of Europe

(480-547) St Benedict was born at Norcia, Italy, and was sent to Rome to be educated. He chose to live a solitary life at Subiaco and eventually organised a form of monastic life in twelve monasteries. The monks who joined St Benedict devoted themselves to work and prayer. In the great abbey on Monte Cassino, which he founded, he wrote his Rule in which are wonderfully combined the Roman genius and the monastic wisdom of the Christian East. He was proclaimed Patron of Europe by Pope St Paul VI because of his wonderful influence in the formation of Christendom in the Middle Ages.

#### Saturday Saint Henry or of Our Lady on Saturday

(973-1024) Henry II, Duke of Bavaria, was crowned Emperor in 1014. He used his power to extend the kingdom of God by promoting missionary work.
